

GREENHOUSE

USF BOTANICAL GARDENS

A Departmental greenhouse has been constructed in the [USF Botanical Gardens](#) at the intersection of USF Pine Drive and USF Alumni Drive. The greenhouse measures 24 feet wide by 30 feet long by 17 feet tall.



The greenhouse is currently used for research conducted by Dr. Christina Richards. Other facilities at the Botanical Gardens, including additional greenhouse space, are also utilized by the Department of Integrative Biology.



Inside the greenhouse are shelves to house trays of plants, and a watering system.



The facility will be available to faculty, post-docs and students conducting research with Dr. Richards.
